GENERAL RULES

- All persons 18 years or older are eligible to enter. Anglers under the age of 18 must fish with parent or quardian.
- Only walleye, sauger & saugeye will be accepted by tournament officials
- Daily limit per team shall be four (4) fish. At no time shall there be more than four (4) fish in the live well. (No more than four (4) fish per team per day
- Only one walleye per day, 23" and over may be retained and three (3) fish 18" and under or up to 4 fish 18" and under.
- Live wells must be used by all teams, live well is a covered aerated container used to retain live fish.
- Tournament hours are 8:00am to 4:00pm and the Weigh-in will be open at 9:00am and will continue throughout the fishing day.
- All measurements will be taken with the tail laid flat and pinched and the mouth closed. (Jaw not in extended position)
- If a contestant submits a fish that is judged to be within the tournaments illegal size, the contestant will be disqualified for that day's weight.

Boundaries:

- All waters accessible by boat on Lake of the Woods are deemed Tournament waters unless stated otherwise by the Tournament Director.
- All waters leading into the first narrows of Shoal Lake downstream from marker No. W10, and all the Labyrinth thereafter are NOT part of Lake of the Woods and are out of bounds for fishing.
- The tournament Director has the right to alter or restrict tournament waters with prompt notice to all registered teams.
